**THE MONUMENT TIMBER RESTORATION PROJECT** Timber restoration work continuing as planned on the south facade (back of the Church building), including the vestry portion. As always, please do not enter the hoarded area, and we encourage you to be extra vigilant from safety point of view.

The next stage, planned to be the west facade (car park side) is now going to split into a number of sub-phases in order to accelerate the programme. The first sub-phase will focus on the southern end of the west facade (facing the allocated Vicar's parking spot) expecting to start at the end of this (July) month. Scaffolding with its associated hoarding will be erected which will have implications for the existing parking lots. Instead of the current side by side "L" parking configuration, it will be converted into a "parallel" parking arrangement - so significantly reduced slots. Those who wish to access these slots will have to reverse into the area as there will be no space for turning. Appropriate signs will be posted to inform prospective users/parkers.

Two lots closest to the front entrance will continue to be allocated for disabled parking. More details will be posted on the bulletin board at the back of the Church building. Do continue to pray for smooth and safe progress of the restoration work.
