**THE MONUMENT TIMBER RESTORATION PROJECT** Timber restoration work is expected to start on the final phase - the "north" facade (front of the Church building). This is probably the most extensive timber scope of all the facades. To access the multiple large louvered windows, hoarded scaffolds will also be erected inside the Church building along the north/front facade which will take up a few rows of individual seats at the back of the Church. The planned completion date of the timber restoration project is expected to be around the end of April 2018.
