THE WORLD

INDONESIA

- Indonesia is the world's fourth most populous nation. About 16% of its people (population 233 million) profess to be Christians.
- Pray for the church in Indonesia, that it may continue boldly to proclaim Christ and bear witness to him. Pray that Christians will not fear the influence of strong occult powers which seek to oppose the gospel, or attempts by groups within the majority religion to eliminate Christianity and remove the presence of the good news. Pray for continued growth of the Church in the midst of intense opposition and growing persecution.
- Pray for the nation as general elections take place on Wednesday this week. Pray for a peaceful and orderly process, and that those elected to office will serve the nation with integrity. For the first time in the country's history, the president, vice president, and members of the People's Consultative Assembly (MPR), will be elected on the same day with over 190 million eligible voters.

MISSION PARTNERS – HERMON LIVING WATERS MINISTRY (HLWM)

- Pray for the HLWM family: the leadership of the Komanapalli family, the faithful pastors and staff who run the ministry, the elementary school and college students (upcoming exams and graduation), the spiritual wellbeing of congregations, and outreach work.
- Pray for the Lord's provision: for the vulnerable and poor in the coming hot season, and for sufficient funds to carry out ministry work.
- Pray for the Lord's protection and peace over potential conflict situations between the church and other faiths.
- Pray for upcoming national elections, that those elected to office will serve for the benefit of all the people, especially minorities.

SINGAPORE DIOCESE

Continue to pray for churches in the Diocese as we all prepare for *Celebration of Hope*. Pray that Christians will take up this opportunity to invite non-Christian friends along to one or more of the meetings to hear the gospel clearly explained.

SINGAPORE

Pray for integrity, vision and strength for all who lead our nation, including our President Mdm Halimah Yacob and our Prime Minister Mr Lee Hsien Loong.
